Bay Street Players continues its summer hit of Rodgers & Hammerstein's beloved musical, *Oklahoma!* The final production in BSP's award-winning 2008-2009 season, *Oklahoma!* is presented through August 2, 2009 at the historic State Theatre in downtown Eustis. Set in a Western Indian Territory just after the turn-of-the-century, the high-spirited rivalry between the local farmers and cowboys provide the colorful background for this Rodgers & Hammerstein classic American love story. Although the road to true love is as bumpy as a surrey ride down a country road, this is one show that 'You Just Can't Say No' to!

With music by Richard Rodgers and Book and Lyrics by Oscar Hammerstein II, *Oklahoma!* is the product of their first collaboration. The musical is based on the play "Green Grow the Lilacs" by Lynn Riggs. Favorite songs include: "Oh, What A Beautiful Mornin'", "The Surrey with the Fringe on Top", "I Cain't Say No!", "People Will Say We're In Love", and "Oklahoma".

Artistic Director **David Clevinger** designed and directed the production. His team includes: **David Brown**, Musical Director; **William Dumas**, Lighting Designer; **Bonnie Swanson**, Costume Designer; **Tara Whitman**, Choreographer, and a cadre of community volunteers.

Oklahoma! began July 10 and continues through August 2. Thursday, Friday, and Saturday performances begin at 8:00 p.m. Sunday matinee performances begin at 2:30 p.m. Also, there is one Wednesday performance on July 29 at 8:00p.m., and one Saturday matinee performance on August 1 at 2:30 p.m. While the production has enjoyed high attendance thus far, there are still tickets available for most days.
